CADET MANUAL: USS ABRAHAM LINCOLN NCC 71809

The purpose of this manual is to include the children of the Starship USS Abraham Lincoln NCC 71809 crewmembers in the activities and life of the Abraham Lincoln

Section 1: Definition of a Cadet

For the purposes of this manual and the Abraham Lincoln, a cadet will be defined as a child between ten (10) and eighteen (18) years of age. He/she is considered to be attending Starfleet Academy (SFA) during this time. Cadet is earning SFA credit for serving on a starship.

Subsection A: Joining the Abraham Lincoln

- 1. All cadets under the age of 17 (seventeen) must be enrolled with a parent.
- 2. Cadets age 17 (seventeen) can enroll with written parental permission.

Subsection B: Attending events

- 1. Cadets under the age of 17 (seventeen) attending ship, sector, regional, fleet, or outside organization events must be accompanied by a parent.
- 2. Cadets age 17 (seventeen) can attend ship, sector, regional, fleet, or outside organization events with written parental permission.
 - 3. Cadets must arrange their own transportation to and from events

Section 2: Cadet Ranks

Subsection A: Entering rank

- a. Beginning rank will be determined by the age of the cadet (see chart below)
 - 1. Cadets entering between ages 13 & 17 will enter with the rank of Cadet Crewman 1st Class

****** A cadet will be granted the adult rank of Crewman 3rd Class upon reaching the age of 18, "graduation" from the academy and achieving a minimum of 400 Promotion Points as Cadet Commander. They will have all the rights and responsibilities commensurate therein.

Subsection B: Advancement in rank

- 1. advancement in rank is achieved by earning promotion points (PP)
- a. Promotion Points for Cadets are earned in the same manner as adult crew with the addition of report card grades
 - 1. report card grades: mid term and final

a. A = 10 PP

b. B = 7 PP

c. C = 5 PP

d. D= 3 PP

Subsection C: Children under age 10

1. Children under age 10 will not have any rank designation and will be considered to be attending primary school on board the Abraham Lincoln, in preparation for enrollment at SFA

Section 3: Amending the Cadet Manual

- 1. This manual will be amended when the need arises.
- 2. Amendments can be proposed by any crew member age 13 and above
- 3. Amendments must be approved by a majority of the crew
